



Information for the Period 1913-1915
President Maggie Norman
Taken from Day Book 1



- Club meetings were now being held in the homes of the members.
- The first President's luncheon was held in February 1914; Seven members attended.
- The members contributed to the Belgium War Relief movement by knitting gloves and scarves.
- The club emphasis was placed on education due to the changing times.
- For many years the club held a Children's Day in April. The members became
 active in getting legislation passed protecting children in the labor movement.
 A bill was passed in 1913, known as the Child Labor Bill, prohibiting children
 from working under the age of sixteen.
